15 th June 2020	Deadline for submission of abstracts (see below)
1 st July 2020	Editors communicate decision of selection procedure
15 th September 2020	Manuscripts submission deadline
25 th September 2020	Feedback from editors
15 th October 2020	Submission of corrected manuscripts (if required)
30 th October 2020	Circulation of galley proofs for proof-reading by authors
15 th December 2020	Publication of Special Issue

Submissions are invited on a wide range of aspects pertaining to social work theory and practice, including research, teaching, policy, advocacy and trade union organisation. No thematic limitation has been decided at this stage, though the editors reserve the right to limit the number of papers dedicated to the same topic, or coming from the same geographical region. Submissions should include a title, abstract (250-500 words), if possible accompanied by a short synopsis (subsection headings).

Upon publication, authors will receive one hardcopy and one PDF of the Special Issue.
